

Collectorpro Appraiser Edition – Cloud (Internal Use Only)

Collectorpro Appraiser Edition is available in a full software install on your local Windows computer or in software that runs on a server or computer in the cloud. This article is intended to provide information about the cloud versions including requirements, access differences, and any restrictions. Collectorpro Appraiser Edition – Cloud is available in a single user or a multi-user version.

Single User

The single user version runs on a Windows PC in the cloud. This is the exact same software as will be installed on your local Windows computer. The software is accessible from almost any internet connected device 24 x 7.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. From what internet connected devices can I access the software?

A. Windows PC, Mac, Internet Browser (Chrome and Firefox), iPad, or Android Tablet.

Q. Is the data safe in the cloud?

A. The software in the cloud stores all your data securely and is backed up with encryption daily. All data in transit across the internet is encrypted as it is being sent. No one has access to your data other than you.

Q. In regards to image files for objects, comparables, and more, how do I get them copied up to the cloud?

A. Files are copied to the cloud into your private storage using your own Dropbox, OneDrive, or Google Drive. All you do is upload the images from your camera to a folder in the Dropbox, OneDrive, or Google Drive and the image files will be copied to your cloud private storage automatically.

Q. Where is my data stored?

A. Data is stored in a secure private data store in Amazon Web Services cloud in the United States of America.

Multi User

The multi user version runs on a dedicated private server in the cloud. This version allows anyone with a Windows PC or Mac that is connected to the internet to access the software. Multiple users can be connected and work on the same, or different appraisals at the same time.

Q. From what internet connected devices can I access the software?

A. Windows PC, Mac, or Internet Explorer browser

Q. Is the data safe in the cloud?

A. The software in the cloud stores all your data securely and is backed up with encryption daily. All data in transit across the internet is encrypted as it is being sent. No one has access to your data other than you.

Q. In regards to image files for objects, comparables, and more, how do I get them copied up to the cloud?

A. The recommended method is to use your own Dropbox, OneDrive, or Google Drive. All you do is upload the images from your camera to a folder in the Dropbox, OneDrive, or Google Drive and the image files will be copied to your cloud server private storage automatically. As an alternative you may copy and paste files and folders from your local computer to the cloud storage.

Q. Where is my data stored?

A. Data is stored in a secure private data store in Amazon Web Services cloud in the United States of America.

Q. Is there a limit to the number of users?

A. No, there is no limit and you may have a minimum of two users and there is no maximum.
